

BridgeNY Funding – CDTC Guidance

Background:

NYSDOT is rolling out BridgeNY funding via a more traditional call for projects with funds distributed through the Regional Offices and MPOs. The new process is intended to address various challenges encountered in previous BridgeNY awards while also streamlining the rollout. One criteria of prior BridgeNY awards was to award at least one project per County. Additionally, NYSDOT has established funding targets by county based on Locally owned deck area in combination with the amount of deficient deck area. These funding targets assign 90% of the BridgeNY funding available, leaving 10% to distribute as needed. Bridge funds are Federal Aid and Culverts are State. The Bridge call for projects represents the component following the MPO process.

- Funding in this table represents 90% of the BridgeNY funds allocated. Region 1 has reserve of \$2.7M to help round out project budgets.
- Of the projects to receive funding, somewhere between 60-75% need to be Off-System.
- Non-NYSDOT owned bridges only.

Culvert Funding:

The Region 1 funding for culverts is \$15.4M and the call for projects will come from the Region for the entire 8 counties.
