PROVIDE EXPLANATION FOR CHANGE:

The City of Cohoes is progressing the subject project and currently under construction. This TIP amendment proposes to increase construction funding through the Carbon Reduction Program. The project requires a construction phase funding increase based on bids received. The apparent low bid exceeded the engineer's estimate, reflecting prevailing market conditions and escalation in construction costs. The additional funds are necessary



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to cover the bid amount and associated construction contingencies, allowing the project to be awarded and constructed as programmed. This amendment does not change the project scope, limits, or purpose; it solely adjusts funding to match actual construction costs identified through the bidding process.
