Re: TIP Amendment - TIP# S265 (PIN 1761.59) and TIP# S285 (PIN 1762.49)

Freemans Bridge Road Sidewalks and Multi-Use Path, Town of Glenville, Schenectady County

Dear Ms. Misiewicz:

The Town of Glenville is submitting the following TIP amendment for consideration by the Planning Committee at its next scheduled meeting.

The amendment is proposed due to the following:

- Scope Change
- Cost Change
- Schedule Change
- Other: Shift Funding

Explanation for Requested Change:

The Town of Glenville has multiple projects progressing along Freemans Bridge Road that are currently at different stages. This TIP amendment proposes to move funding between two PIN's that are both located on Freemans Bridge Road in order to better align with the stage of design that it corresponds to.

Pre-FFY 2023, TIP# S265 (PIN 1761.59) was a project to design and construct a multi-use path from Freemans Bridge to Dutch Meadows Lane on the west side of Freemans Bridge Road. That portion of the project finalized construction in Fall 2025.. Concurrently, TAP funding was awarded to the Town to design and construct sidewalks on Freemans Bridge Road in the same project limits, but on the east side of the roadway, and the respective TAP funding was added to PIN 1761.59.

The Town is proposing to shift TAP funding from PIN 1761.59 to PIN 1762.49. Additionally, the State has agreed to use NHPP funding to fund the paving and associated traffic items for the project.

This TIP amendment is proposing to shift funding between existing projects to align with the scope of work while also adding additional construction inspection funding due to the increased construction cost from the State paving work. Please see the following tables describing the existing TIP and our proposed changes:
