**APPROVAL OF THE ALBANY – SCHENECTADY – TROY 1997 8-HOUR OZONE NON-ATTAINMENT AREA
TRANSPORTATION / AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY DETERMINATION FOR IN MOTION: THE PLAN TO 2050**

WHEREAS, the Capital Region Transportation Council has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for the four-county metropolitan planning area of Albany, Rensselaer, Saratoga, and Schenectady counties, except the Town of Moreau and the Village of South Glens Falls, as required by Title 23, U.S.C. Section 134 and Title 49 U.S.C. Section 5303; and,

WHEREAS, federal law requires the Transportation Council to prepare a metropolitan transportation plan and a Transportation Improvement Program for the Capital Region; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Council has developed a new metropolitan transportation plan requiring the adoption of a new transportation air quality conformity determination for the seven-county Albany-Schenectady-Troy, NY ozone nonattainment area; and,

WHEREAS, the Transportation Council collaborated with the New York State Department of Transportation Regions 1, 2 and 9 and the Adirondack/Glens Falls Transportation Council to develop the requisite draft air quality conformity determination to accompany the Transportation Council's metropolitan transportation plan; and,

WHEREAS, that determination included no air quality non-exempt projects within the seven-county Albany-Schenectady-Troy, NY ozone nonattainment area; and,

WHEREAS, the Transportation Council's Planning Committee, the New York State Department of Transportation and the Adirondack/Glens Falls Transportation Council's Planning Committee reviewed and approved the draft air quality conformity determination, releasing it for public review.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that following completion of the public review period, the Transportation Council has approved the Albany-Schenectady-Troy 1997 8-Hour Ozone Non-Attainment Area Transportation/Air Quality Conformity Determination related to the Transportation Council's new metropolitan transportation plan known as In Motion: The Plan to 2050; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Transportation Council directs the Secretary to submit this resolution and appropriate documentation of the program through the New York State Commissioner of Transportation to the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration.
