

RESOLUTION #26-4

TITLE VI ANALYSIS APPROVAL

WHEREAS, the Capital Region Transportation Council (Transportation Council) has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) responsible, together with the State, for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for the four-county metropolitan planning area of Albany, Rensselaer, Saratoga, and Schenectady counties, except the Town of Moreau and the Village of South Glens Falls, as required by 23 U.S.C 134 and 49 U.S.C. 5303; and,

WHEREAS, Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Circular 4702.1B establishes Title VI requirements and guidelines for the Transportation Council as a recipient of FTA funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Transportation Council adopted the 2025-2030 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) on June 5, 2025 and a new metropolitan transportation plan (MTP) on September 4, 2025, known as In Motion: The Plan to 2050; and,

WHEREAS, the Transportation Council updated its Title VI Analysis as a result of the adoption of a new TIP and MTP to comply with the requirements of FTA Circular 4702.1B to ensure that both the benefits and possible negative impacts of transportation planning study recommendations and transportation system investments conducted and funded by the Transportation Council and its member agencies are fairly distributed; and,

WHEREAS, the Transportation Council's Planning Committee reviewed and approved the Draft Title VI Analysis, releasing it for public review.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that following completion of the public review period, the Transportation Council has approved the Title VI Analysis; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Transportation Council's Secretary is directed to transmit this action to appropriate state and federal agencies and that the Transportation Council's staff is directed to publish and disseminate copies of the final report to Transportation Council members and other interested parties.
