

RESOLUTION #25-11

ADOPTION OF IN MOTION: THE PLAN TO 2050

WHEREAS, the Capital Region Transportation Council (Transportation Council) has been designated by the Governor of the State of New York as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) responsible for the comprehensive, continuing, and cooperative transportation planning process for the Capital District Transportation Management Area (TMA) which includes Albany, Rensselaer, Saratoga, and Schenectady counties, except the Town of Moreau and the Village of South Glens Falls, as required by Title 23 U.S.C. Section 134 and Title 49 U.S.C. Section 5303; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Council is responsible for developing and adopting a metropolitan transportation plan for the Capital Region; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Council adopted the current metropolitan transportation plan known as New Visions 2050 Plan in September 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Council has worked with the Capital District Transportation Authority, New York State Department of Transportation, the Transportation Council's member agencies and organizations, municipalities, community stakeholders, and the general public to prepare a new metropolitan transportation plan known as In Motion: The Plan to 2050; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Council certifies that its planning process meets all requirements of federal law; and

WHEREAS, In Motion: The Plan to 2050 satisfies the requirements of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (2021); and

WHEREAS, the air quality conformity determination statement for the Albany-Schenectady-Troy, NY area was completed as per the federal transportation conformity regulations, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Transportation Council adopts In Motion: The Plan to 2050 as the metropolitan transportation plan for the Capital Region.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Transportation Council's Secretary is directed to transmit this action to appropriate state and federal agencies and that the Transportation Council's staff is directed to publish and disseminate copies of the final report to Transportation Council members, appropriate agencies, and other interested parties.
